

## HUGO DACHINGER

born in 1908 in Gmunden, Austria

- 1918-25 works in his fathers business and becomes travel salesman
- 1925 works as a window dresser and artist in Linz, Austria
- 1933-37 lives in Vienna and works as an international advertising designer
- 1938 flees to London due to the upcoming threat in Austria and Germany  
works as an artist in London and also keeps an atelier in Kensington
- 1941 was released after 7 months in internment camps
- 1941-56 works for the "Free Austrian Movement" and the "Young Austrian Centre"
- 1978 retires, but continues to paint
- 1993 becomes a honorary citizen of the Town of Gmunden
- 1995 he dies on the 2<sup>nd</sup> December in London

## EDUCATION

- 1914-18 elementary school in Gmunden (starts to paint still lives)
- 1919-29 completes formal education
- 1929-32 Study under Walter Thiele (1889-1965) in the advertising department of the School of Arts and Crafts in Leipzig, also teaches photography here
